

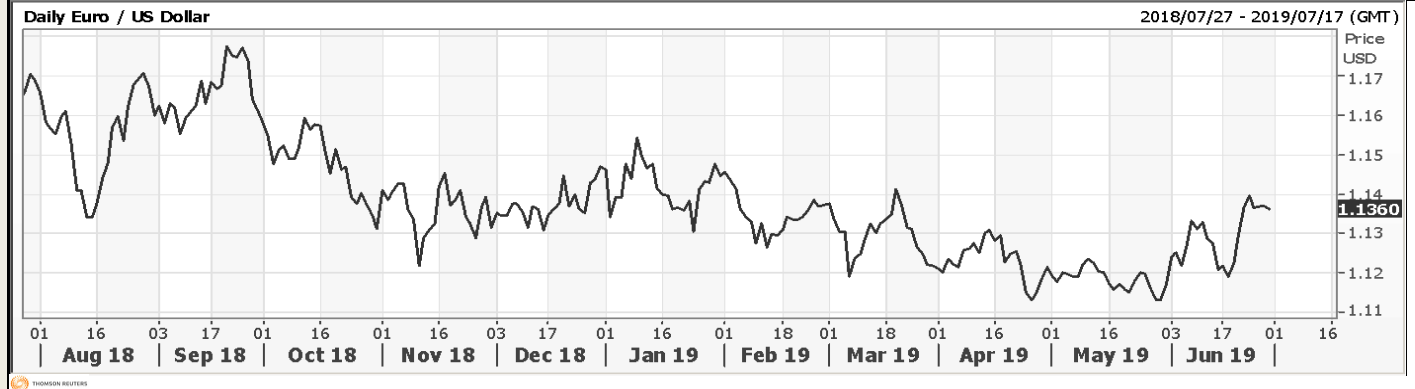

Markets remained optimistic of a potential trade deal between the US and China on the weekend. US GDP for the first quarter was released in line with the forecasted 3.1%. US initial jobless claims was released higher at 227,000 compared to the Reuters forecasted 220,000. US continued jobless claims also printed higher at 1.688M compared to the Reuters forecasted 1.665M. The Euro Zone consumer confidence was released at -7.2%. US PMI and consumption figures; UK GDP figures and current account balance and; Euro Zone CPI figures are anticipated later today. Gold reached a high of USD1412.28(ask) an ounce.

Yesterday the rand was range bound and reached a high of 14.2775 (ask) and a low of 14.1341 (ask). South Africa's PPI printed slightly better at 6.4% compared to the Reuters forecasted 6.3%. The SA Reserve Bank deputy governor Daniel Mminele has resigned, with speculation that he could be in line for a senior role at one of the big 4 banks in South Africa. The petrol price is anticipated to decrease next month. Wet weather and gale force winds are forecasted for the Western Cape. In other news, the duke and duchess of Sussex will be visiting South Africa later this year after the birth of their son Archie. Today, South Africa's trade balance, money supply and credit extensions to the private sector is anticipated.
